SWIMMING POOLS

When considering the possible use of a swimming pool, leaders should check the following;

- Is lifeguard supervision constantly available? If not, at least one member of staff should have a relevant life saving award and be supported by adult supervision in the ratio of 1:10 (as a minimum). There should be first aid, rescue equipment and a means of summoning assistance available at the poolside.
- Is the pool and its immediate surrounds clean and regularly serviced?
- Are pool depths marked and suitable for the particular group?
- Is the water clear and of an appropriate temperature?
- Are changing and showering facilities safe and hygienic?
- Does the pool cater for people with disabilities?
- Does the pool cater for any religious or cultural factors?
- Is there a poolside telephone, or other means of summoning immediate assistance?

The use of natural waters for swimming and paddling is potentially highly hazardous. Such activities should normally take place at recognised sites which have adequate and competent/qualified supervision. Informal or unsupervised swimming or paddling must not be permitted.
